Dear Parents and Students,

The following information will help guide you through the procedures of our yearend recital. We require that everyone, parents, family and friends to follow the information provided as well as review our "**IMPORTANT DATES**" located on the website to avoid any upsets. The year-end show allows our dancers an opportunity to perform on stage in front of a large audience. Each class has a number to perform and is rehearsed during their regular class time throughout the season. Our year our year-end recital is held at the Port Theatre with one evening performance at 6:00 pm. All tickets are sold through the Port Theatre box office starting on April 17th. Dancers who are planning to watch the show are required to purchase a ticket - all seats are assigned seating. If your dancer is only performing in the first or second half, they will need a ticket. When dancers are finished performing in the first half of the show, they must be picked up at Intermission, as dancers are not permitted to wait backstage when finished. Please be sure to **DOUBLE CHECK** the **SHOW PROGRAM** (attached) prior to purchasing your tickets, to ensure if they are dancing only in the first half, second half or both. All tickets are non refundable.

ATTENDANCE FOR ALL REHEARSALS - All rehearsals are **mandatory** for students to attend. If for some reason your child is not planning to perform in the recital, we must be notified immediately. A lot of planning and details go into each and every class performance. Your child's absence at any of these events could alter or change their group settings. Dancers, who do not attend, without any notice, will not be performing in the recital.

BUSINESS CARDS AND SPONSORING - Parents can place a business card ad in the program by sending card information and payment to the studio no later than **May 11th**. Business Card ads are \$60.00 and payable to Tempo Dance Academy. Larger size ads are also available, please ask Ms. Irene for details. Please send camera-ready to **tempodanceacademy@shaw.ca**

FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO TAPING - Flash Photography is strictly prohibited during the shows as this a danger to everyone on stage. Videotaping of the show is prohibited due to copyright laws. Please be respectful of these rules to our guests.

FLOWERS – Whether it is your dancers' first or last dance recital, gifting them with flowers after a flawless performance is a traditional gesture to express how proud you are of their dancing achievements. An order form is attached for those who wish to purchase ahead of time. All flowers ordered can be picked up at the theatre at the start of the evening show. Single stem flowers will also be available for purchase at the show before & during intermission for \$5.00.

FOOD AND DRINKS - At the Port Theatre guests are not permitted food or beverages inside the theatre or backstage. Dancers performing are permitted to bring their own water bottle and safe snacks inside their dressing rooms. Please do not send anything that can spill on costumes and **NO PEANUTS or NUTS** of any kind please!

HAIR - On recital day, students are to arrive at the Theatre <u>ONE HOUR</u> prior to show time. Please be sure to have your dancer ready at home and arrive in costume with hair and makeup done. We do not have space backstage or in the hallways for parents or visitors to do hair. All dancers arrive with a tight **BALLET BUN** with bangs gelled back off the face and secured with a **HAIR NET** that matches your hair color. Please do not put any accessories in the hair or Bun.

JEWELERY - Unless this is part of your costume, no jewelry is permitted onstage during rehearsal or performances. If required a parent volunteer or teacher will remove it backstage. We find this upsetting for the younger students, so please remove all of your child's jewelry at home. Belly button rings must either be removed or covered up with tape under their costumes. Please remove all nail polish from fingernails and toes if you are dancing in bare feet.

MAKE UP (for all dancers) - PRESCHOOL, KINDERMIX, PRE-PRIMARY & GRADE ONE - Red lipstick, blush, with no eye makeup. GRADES TWO TO SENIOR - Red lipstick, blush, black eyeliner, brown eye shadow. Students should bring a makeup and repair kit to both rehearsal and recital day. It should contain makeup, extra tights/nylons, second skins, hairpins, brush and /or comb, hair spray/gel. Make up will not be supplied backstage.

MEDICAL CONCERNS - Parents must inform the studio of any **ALLERGIES** to make up, hair spray etc. Parents that have children with any medical concerns must inform Ms. Irene prior to the show or any of the rehearsals. Please make necessary arrangements with Ms. Irene if medical supplies are required backstage. **RAFFLE ITEMS -** The Tempo Parent Group appreciates gift basket donations for the year-end recital and will accept items up until the last week of classes. Proceeds from the raffle help fund the bursary and scholarship program. Tickets for the raffle basket will be available to purchase during Intermission with the draws taking place at the end of the show. Parents can make a donation of any kind, cash, coffee, tea, wine, chocolate, spa items, boy and girls toys, gift cards, etc. Please drop off your items at the office during office hours. Thank you, for your support!

RECITAL T-SHIRTS – All dancers in competitive grades three to senior levels are required to purchase a Finale t-shirt as part of their costume. If your child is not in finale, and you wish to order, please fill out the form attached and return it to the studio or email with payment by April 29th. All t-shirts will be given out during show rehearsals. Please note: We will not be taking additional orders past this date. T-shirts cost \$30.00 incl. taxes and shipping.

STUDENT BURSARIES AND AWARDS - All student awards and bursaries are announced at the end of the year. Thank you to the **TEMPO PARENT GROUP** who contributes their fundraising efforts to make these awards possible. Awards are chosen from the Instructors who send in their recommendations based on the criteria set out by the school.

VIDEO LINKS of the RECITAL - The studio fundraising raised enough to cover the cost of our specialized professional videographer to film our show during the recital. Once the video is completed, we will send out a video link to each of our families sometime late June.

YEAR END PERFORMANCES - During recital performances – all dancers are to arrive **ONE-HOUR** prior to the show at 5:00 pm. The show will begin at 6:00 pm. Viewing is restricted to ticket holders only. During the recital, access doors between backstage and the lobby will be locked and monitored by our parent volunteers. Only parents and guardians will be permitted to enter the backstage area to either drop off or gather their children. Parents can pick up their dancer backstage (loading bay) during intermission or at the end of show. Dancers will not be released out of dressing rooms any other time during the show.

THANK EVERYONE in advance for your co-operation and understanding with all the procedures and policies. This is to ensure the safety of the children and it allows us all to run a smooth and successful recital. Please be sure to contact us if you have any questions if information is not clear.

PICTURE DAY @ the Studio SUNDAY MAY 5th

All students participate on **<u>PICTURE DAY</u>** whether you purchase pictures or not. This allows us to view our dancers in full costume, check names for the program and make any necessary changes if needed. Our professional photographer is offering a group picture and an individual photo for each dancer. Photos are also available for Solos and Duets. All photos will be a digital download.

Dancers are to arrive **<u>30 MINUTES</u>** prior to their picture time posted below – in costume, hair and make up done. Hair is to be in a tight BALLET BUN with bangs gelled back with a hair net secured with pins. If we have missed anyone on this schedule please advise the office ASAP.

We always run on time however, when dancers are not at the studio "dancer ready" - we fall behind! With limited space in the common area and washrooms, we ask that you come "<u>Dancer Ready</u>" to avoid congestion. Parents will drop their dancer at the front studio door where they will proceed to their holding studio. If you have multiple costume changes, come dressed in your first outfit.

Be sure to LABEL ALL OF YOUR ITEMS!

Parents are asked to either wait in their vehicles or come back after the photo time for pick up. <u>MAKE UP</u> - Dancers from Pre-school up to Grade One – Blush and lipstick, no other make up is required. Dancers from Grade Two and up – follow your competition guidelines for make up.

PICTURE FORMS – Will be provided as soon as they become available. Please fill out them out and return them on <u>**PICTURE DAY</u>** only with payment cheque or cash. All pictures will be done electronically. After picture day, parents who have placed an order will receive a link to download their photos. Students are welcome to have pictures taken of their solos or duets in between group times. Please advise us on the day when you arrive and we will fit you in when there is a spot. All dancers are pre posed for groups as well as for individual shots. If a dancer has a specific pose they would like for their individual shot, be sure to practice that pose and be ready. Please do not arrive at the studio unprepared!</u>

THE PORT THEATRE DRESS REHEARSAL – WEDNESDAY, MAY 29th

This rehearsal is for <u>ALL DANCERS</u> performing in the recital. We ask that you make this a priority in your schedule. Please follow the procedures for **DRESS REHEARSAL** listed in this newsletter.

On this day, dancers arrive in costume, hair in a tight ballet bun, gelled back with hairspray, hairnets – with no bangs. **NOTE:** Make up is not required for this rehearsal. Dancers are to arrive at the theatre **45 minutes** before their stage time. All students are to arrive at the back of the theatre (loading bay) where dancers will be checked in and escorted to their assigned dressing rooms by volunteer supervisors. Please do not be late as we are not able to wait for dancers. Plan to leave early to avoid traffic and enough time for parking. During this time, parents can wait outside or visit the local coffee shops nearby. There is no seating in the loading bay and the theatre is not open during this time. Parents can pick up their dancers (loading bay) when they have finished rehearsing. Students will not be released out of the building until a parent picks them up and checks them out.

PARKING IN THE LOADING BAY- parents are not to park in this area. All cars not assigned will be towed at your expense.

THEATRE DRESSING ROOMS

Please remember that we are renting this theatre and we expect that all dancers will respect the Port Theatre's property. Any dancer found damaging property by way of coloring on walls, lipstick on mirrors, or any other form of damage will be immediately be sent home. Parents will be responsible for any damage occurred by their children and will be directed to the Port Theatre staff. All dancers must check for personal items before leaving the theatre. The theatre lost and found is located at the audience service desk in the lobby and can be accessed the following day. The studio is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Do not bring anything of value to the theatre. All dancers will be required to clean up their dressing rooms at the end of each day. They will not be released until they have clearance from staff. **BE SURE TO LABEL ALL OF YOUR ITEMS**!
